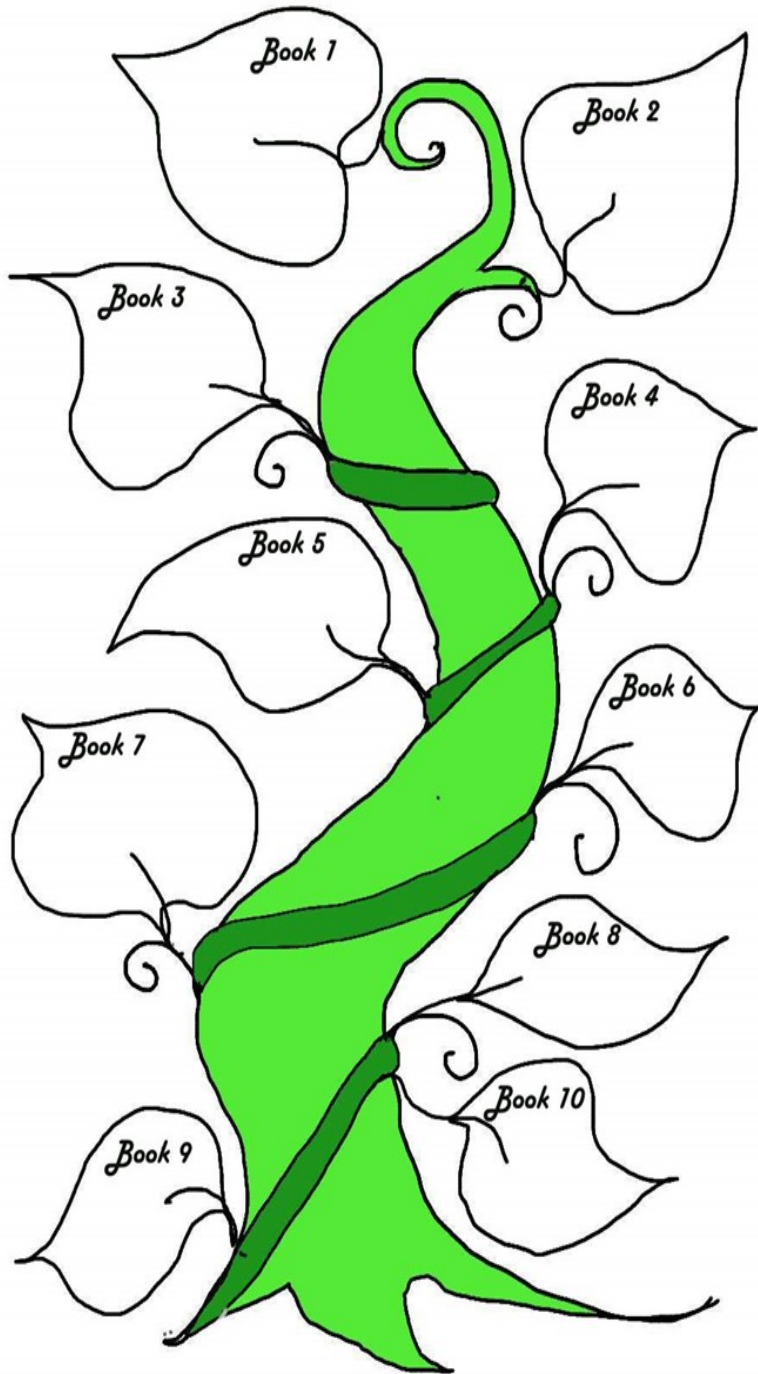




# The Children's Library Summer Reading Challenge 2020!

Welcome to our Summer Reading Challenge 2020.

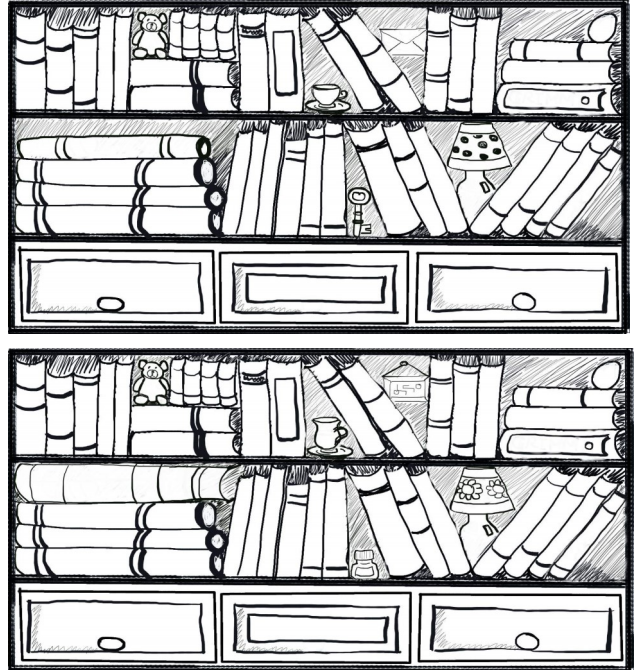
Fill in the leaves on the Beanstalk with 10 titles of books you have read over the summer and bring the completed form to the library when we re-open to collect a reward.
